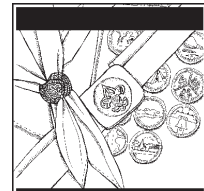

## Danny Howe

Danny Howe was born and raised in Birmingham, Alabama, where his family was very active in The United Methodist Church and the camping ministries of the North Alabama Annual Conference. While in school, he was very active in band and enjoyed fishing and wood working.

He attended to Jefferson State Jr. College and Athens State College.

Danny began his career as a contractor in Birmingham and continued this craft when moving to Kingsport to be supportive of family with medical issues.

He began working in missions at First Broad Street United Methodist Church in 1985, when he and his wife, Debbie, were sent to Johns Island, South Carolina as missionaries. Danny worked with teams coming to the Sea Islands to rehab housing, while Debbie worked with the East Coast Migrant Head Start Project.

After two years, Danny and Debbie returned home and started a local mission ministry called Carpenters Helpers Ministry. This ministry was designed to address the housing rehab needs in the Kingsport area, while engaging the congregation of First Broad Street and the community in transformational experiences of service.

In 1989, Danny returned to Johns Island after Hurricane Hugo devastated the South Carolina coast and spent two years helping coordinate work teams in rebuilding efforts of the Sea Islands.

Danny and his family returned to FBSUMC in 1992, where he has remained on staff and currently serves as Director of Missions. Debbie is employed at the Child Center as assistant director and teacher of four-year-olds. They have been blessed with three children Virginia, Matt and Madeline.

Danny currently serves as chairperson of the Holston Conference Mission Ministry Team, as well as serving on the boards of several ministries and agencies within the region. He enjoys leading teams on national and international mission experiences and is heavily involved in Native American mission opportunities. Danny's teaching is a theology based on missions as a lifestyle, not an event. He has played a significant role in the relationship between Holston Annual Conference, The United Methodist Church in South Sudan and the General Board of Global Ministries. He celebrates the significance of The United Methodist Church in the transformation of a people oppressed for so long and the formation of a new nation based on God's will for the people of South Sudan. Danny continues to travel to South Sudan to broaden the efforts of The United Methodist Church at a very critical time in the history of this new nation, South Sudan.



## Rev. Dr. Charles Kyker

At the age of 17, Charles Clinton Kyker felt an undeniable call to ordained ministry. He applied and was accepted into Greensboro College to pursue a degree in religion and philosophy, studying under Dr. James E. Hull, Dr. Barnes Tatum, Drs. Chris Wilson and Doug Megahey. Charles learned eastern religions and ancient philosophy, while maintaining a yearning for biblical scholarship. He was approved by the Greensboro District Board of ordained ministry to pursue his calling by attending Emory's Candler School of Theology as a Sherman Scholar due to his passion for evangelism. In June 1987, Charles Kyker was ordained as a Deacon in The United Methodist Church in the Western North Carolina Annual Conference.



Charles earned his Master of Theology degree from Duke Divinity School in 1997 and his Doctoral degree in Ministry from Asbury Theological Seminary in 2005, while serving various appointments in the Western North Carolina Conference.

### 1998 - 150 Average Attendance; 2011 - Five Campuses

Charles and his wife, Julie, arrived at Christ United Methodist Church, Hickory, in July 1998 from Asbury Seminary's Beeson Center for Advanced Church Leadership and Biblical Preaching. At the time, Christ UMC had 150 in average attendance, a membership of 153 and offered two worship services in their store front location on Highway 127. The church was six years old and employed one part-time staff person.

As of December 2010, Christ Church had 2,162 in average worship attendance and just over 1,400 members who are served by 30 paid staff and 150 trained lay pastors who lead life groups and vital ministries.

Christ Church added its second campus, Christ-Statesville, Dec. 14, 2004; launched its third campus, Christ-St. Stephens, on Oct. 1, 2006 with 356 in worship and its fourth campus, Christ-Fairgrove, on Easter Sunday 2010, with 645 in attendance. The fifth campus, Christ-Troutman, in the Lake Norman area, was launched in November 2010

Charles and Julie have three daughters in college, MaryGrace, Ashley Beth, Molly Ann and a son, Joseph, who is a high school junior. They also have two granddaughters, Alice and Joanna.



## The Rev. Dr. James Long, Jr.

Active in United Methodist Men for many years, the Rev. Dr. James B. Long, Jr., brought his Methodist background to the work of The Children's Home from 1986 to 2000, when he retired.

Prior to becoming executive director of the Home, he served as pastor of WNCC churches, as well as president of the North Carolina and southeastern Child Care Association. The Family Restoration Program facility in Franklin was named in his honor in 2000. He serves as assistant Chaplain at the Triad United Methodist Home, Inc., in Winston-Salem.
