Western North Carolina United Methodist Men Ministerial Scholarship

Policies and Conditions

The WNCC UMM Ministerial Scholarship fund (established in May, 1982) is designed to assist men and women who have felt God's call into Christian ministry from another vocation or career.

The Scholarship's purpose is to provide financial aid for preparation of these persons.

The applicant must be enrolled as a theological degree candidate at any accredited United Methodist Seminary approved by the Western North Carolina Conference.

The applicant must be able to demonstrate a need for aid.

Aid is intended for those persons who have expressed an intention to serve as parish ministers in the Western North Carolina Conference.

It is preferred that the applicant be certified as a candidate for ministry.
